As a Camp Toccoa Counselor, you could:

Live in a cabin with 8 campers or lead a group of day campers

Spend your morning teaching camp activities

Spend your afternoons leading fun adventures for your group of campers

Spend your evenings dressing up in costumes, cooking outside, camping under a starry sky, and making every moment special

Teach campers life lessons, while learning some yourself

WHAT WE EXPECT:

All our staff members are expected to be responsible, mature, and committed individuals. While camp offers exciting adventures and lasting memories, Camp Toccoa counselors also face high expectations, challenges and hard work. You must be able to be self-motivated, possess leadership skills and be dedicated to working with youth.

A DAY IN THE LIFE:

Wake up at 7:00 am to a group of campers. Get them ready for the day.

Spend the morning teaching (or assisting teaching) activities.

In the afternoon, you'll have an hour of Free Swim and also get to plan a special activity just for your group. You can spend this time splashing in one of camp's waterfalls, hiking to an overlook, or just going on an adventure!

Evening Activities include counselor hunts, banquets and theme parties, Wednesday night cookouts, or sleeping under the stars!

Camp Staff have two hours off each day, and about 20 hours off once each week. The rest of your time is spent looking after, playing with, teaching, and being a role model for campers age 5-17. We expect our staff to present a positive example for our campers at all times.
