Our most popular program, **TRADITIONAL CAMP** gives children the opportunity to enjoy unique experiences, develop new skills, enjoy their natural surroundings and make lasting friendships all in a safe and fun environment. Campers choose their own morning activities (see photos below) and each afternoon is different! Campers have the opportunity to swim everyday and can also explore all camp has to offer (including two waterfalls, countless wooded trails, overlooks, caves and more) all with the encouragement and support of our trained and caring staff. Campers will also be able to experience sharing a cabin with a group of peers, cooking out over a campfire and camping out under the stars.

Campers in our **OWANYAKE DAY CAMP** are able to choose their morning activities just like our overnight campers, while still returning home each night. Day camp also includes swimming and lunch each day! For campers in rising grades K-1, we offer **Junior Day Camp** with programs tailored to the interests and abilities of this age group.

SPECIALTY PROGRAMS

Horseback Camp grades 4-9 • \$580

One-week program focused on riding skills and the principles of caring for and partnering with a horse. Days are spent at WoHeLo Stables, while evenings are spent enjoying a variety of camp-wide activities.

Gypsy Camp grades 7-10 • \$580

One-week program in which campers will be able to work towards earning their 'Gypsy' outdoor living Honor. This specialty camp includes a multi-night camping trip and focuses on outdoor skills.

Voyager Camp grades 9-12 • \$1,100 two weeks

Two-week program in which campers will be able to work towards earning their 'Voyager' outdoor living Honor. This specialty camp includes a multi-night backpacking trip on the Appalachian Trail, to be planned and led by the campers themselves. For campers who wish to learn leadership skills as well as progress in their outdoor living experience.
